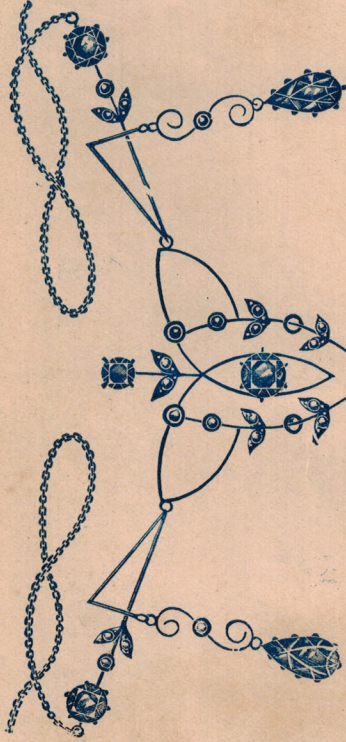

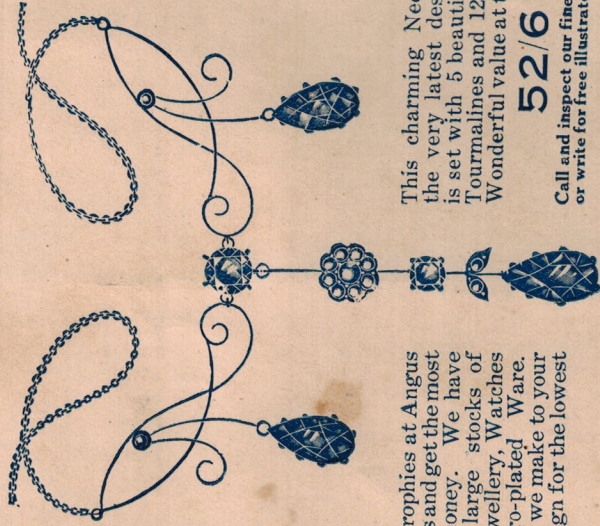

2. Competitors must be ready to take their places at the starting post when called, or they will be debarred from starting.
3. Anyone bathing between events will be expelled from the baths. No person shall enter the water, except the actual competitors, under penalty of suspension.
4. Only Officials and Competitors will be allowed on starting board.
5. The Referee will settle all disputes that may arise, and his decision shall be final.
6. Lady Competitors must wear cloaks to the starting board.
7. Competitors must touch end of bath (above water) on completion of each lap.
